General Reminders for Exams

- All students must write the exam for all courses that have an exam.
- All examinations are to be written only during the scheduled time. **Vacation, employment and/or appointments must not be scheduled during the examination schedule.** Missed exams will result in an exam mark of zero.
- If a student is ill, they must inform the school immediately so that alternate arrangements for the examination can be considered. Failure to inform the school may result in an exam mark of zero.
- Final examinations for grade 9 and 10 courses are 2 hours in length. Final examinations for grade 11 and 12 courses are 2½ hours in length. Exams for Grade 12U courses may be up to 3 hours in length.
- **After the exams scheduled for the day are finished, students are expected to go home.** Unique situations may be considered, in which case, the student must remain in a designated classroom to study.
