EVERYDAY GOSPEL THREADS

I have declared thy faithfulness and thy salvation: I have not concealed thy lovingkindness and thy truth. (Psalm 40:10)

One of the most underestimated influences in our lives is our everyday talk; the talk which happens in the unplanned moments of our routine, ordinary days. Some questions worth asking are ‘What does my everyday talk sound like? What does it include and exclude? Does it include the communication of faith in God? Is it meaningful and edifying?’

Our everyday conversations are a vital part of God’s design in making known the beauty of biblical truths, including the themes of the majesty of His creation, the glory of His plan of redemption, and the anticipation of His final return. The truths of scripture need not be awkward intrusions into our conversations, but, as stated in Deuteronomy 6:7, are to be seamlessly woven into the fabric of our everyday interactions.

In Philemon 1:4-6, scripture challenges us to effectually communicate our faith. Here Paul, under inspiration, writes, “I thank my God, making mention of thee always in my prayers, hearing of thy love and faith, which thou hast toward the Lord Jesus, and toward all saints; that the communication of thy faith may become effectual by the acknowledging of every good thing which is in you in Christ Jesus.”

This year’s theme focusses on five major gospel truths or “threads”: (1) the character of God, (2) the sinfulness of man, (3) the sufficiency of Christ, (4) the necessity of faith, and (5) the urgency of eternity. The goal is not only to learn about these gospel threads, but also to be challenged and to be equipped as students and staff, and to integrate these threads into our everyday conversations. Being saved by grace through faith is the foundation of an authentic Biblical worldview which connects to every aspect of our daily lives. Our collective prayer is that God would deepen our understanding of the beautiful tapestry of the gospel, and that we would respond in faith and obedience.
